...For the future of gas

We're working hard to highlight the role of alternative gases in helping the UK to reach its decarbonisation targets by 2050. We're continuing to work with our partners Cadent, on plans to use hydrogen to heat homes, securing £14.9m funding for **HyDeploy2**. The money will fund two field trials on public gas networks, blending hydrogen with natural gas to heat 750 homes in each year-long trial.

We're also continuing to support national efforts to investigate the potential of 100% hydrogen conversion of the gas network. Following our groundbreaking **H21 Leeds City Gate report**, we're now exploring the potential for hydrogen to heat millions of homes across the North of England. Launched in late November, our **H21 North of England report** is a scenario showing how hydrogen can be delivered via the existing gas network to the North's major urban centres, in order to tackle climate change.

...On future transport networks

Last November, our Head of Programme Management, Tim Harwood, led our Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Conference. Over 50 stakeholders joined us in Newcastle, to help to shape our future approach to CNG infrastructure projects and shared some great ideas on how we can help make a CNG transport network happen.
