Joining the pledge to boost social mobility in wake of COVID-19



As an award-winning employer across the North of England, Northern Gas Networks (NGN) is already well-placed to be a driving force for positive change in the communities it serves. But with the challenge of a post-Covid 19 recovery ahead, it's now time to go further; to level up the playing field for talent, and create more ambitious opportunities for young people in the region.

This month, we launched our **Opportunity Action Plan**, in partnership with former Secretary of State for Education, the Rt Hon. Justine Greening, and the **Social Mobility Pledge** campaign. The fund focuses on supporting innovative approaches to delivering sustainable initiatives that help broaden our reach and educate and support communities and individuals. Project must support at least one of the following objectives:

- Alleviating hardship associated with fuel poverty
- Carbon Monoxide (CO) awareness
- Encouraging interest in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) subjects
- Promote use of the Priority Services Register and or energy efficiency advice

• This year, you can also apply for funding if you are an organisation working around food poverty for people particularly affected by Covid-19
