New text messaging trial launched to improve customer service

As part of our ongoing strategy to improve the customer journey at NGN, our Connections team have linked up with an organisation called Localz, who will be able to offer us real-time stakeholder engagement with location tracking and two-way customer communications, along with both service and product delivery.

The joint project will deliver a text messaging service to our customers, providing them with real time updates on the progress of their project.

The text service will initially focus on planning and delivery, with texts being sent to confirm the start date, to remind our customers of the upcoming appointments and to give progress updates about the works from our engineers.

We are currently working on the design and build phase of the project, with testing scheduled to start mid-April and a prospective go live date of around mid-late May.

We know how important it is that our customers get up-todate information and we're hoping this project will help us to deliver real improvement in that part of the customer journey!

NGN successfully trials gas leak detecting robots



This month, we successfully trialed some high-tech robots on our network, that can effectively detect leaks in water and gas pipes.

Designed and built in Yorkshire, the LeakVISION robots can be deployed remotely for long distances, reducing the excavation needed to locate a leak and minimising environmental impact.

Harrogate-based Synovate, part of the Synthotech Group, has invested over £1.2m and spent two years developing this next generation of robots, which can sense water and gas leaks from within the pipes. Synovate is also developing robots to find hydrogen leaks.

Simon Langdale, engineering director at Synovate, said: "The LeakVISION robots will make it easier and faster to identify and fix leaks, which will be a significant benefit to the environment. In addition, deploying robots saves time and resources over traditional excavation methods."
